

## **KAMLOOPS UNITED ON SITE ALCOHOL USE POLICY**

Permission may be granted by Kamloops United Management Team (MT) that beer and wine may be served in modest use at an event being held at Kamloops United Church. The Management Team has the right to refuse alcohol usage without cause. Permission will only be allowed at an event as described below:

### **POLICY:**

It is the policy of Kamloops United that alcohol (beer/wine) may be served at Church-sponsored and rental events consistent with the requirements listed below:

1. Servers must have Serving It Right certification.
2. An event licence from the Government of B.C. to serve alcohol.
3. Special event liability insurance.
4. Private Event – Invited guests only.
  - i. No advertising about the event.
  - ii. Alcohol will not be sold for profit.
  - iii. Permit applications must be submitted at least 10 days prior to the event.
  - iv. Alcohol will be limited to wine and/or beer.
5. Non-alcoholic beverages and food must also be available.
6. Alcohol service must finish one hour before the event ends.
7. The event license from the Government of B.C must be displayed publicly during the event.
8. The sales receipts/proof of purchase must be readily available during the event in case of a visit from an inspector.
9. Sign a form declaring they will be responsible for any damage to building or property during the course of the event.
10. All garbage and empty bottles are removed from the premises upon the conclusion of the event.
11. No smoking or vaping within 15 feet of any entrance and away from the 429 condo building.
