

KAMLOOPS UNITED CHURCH GAMING POLICIES

POLICY:

It is the policy of Kamloops United that grants that are the result of gaming proceeds may be accepted by Kamloops United.

*NOTE as per Kamloops United Governance Manual Executive Limitation 9, No grant application can be made on behalf of Kamloops United without the knowledge of Council Circle and without the signature of Council Circle Chair.

POLICY:

It is the policy of Kamloops United that gambling is not allowed on the premise.

The following activities are not allowed

- Bingo.
- 50/50 draws.
- Games of chance for money.

The following are not considered gambling under the law. They are allowed at Kamloops United with the listed legal restrictions and Kamloops United policies:

1. Raffles:
 - a. With the permission of Kamloops United Management Team at least two weeks prior to the event.
 - b. Tickets are not to be sold before the event. *
 - c. All tickets must be sold at the location during the event.
 - d. The raffle prize cannot be money.
2. Prize competitions and free draws:
 - a. With the permission of Kamloops United Management Team at least two weeks prior to the event.
 - b. The entirety of the prize competition or draw must be run start to finish during the event day time fame. (i.e. cannot start before the day of the event and cannot extend to the days after the event.)
3. Silent Auctions:
 - a. With the permission of Kamloops United Management Team at least two weeks prior to the event.

* (Under the GPEB; when tickets are not sold in advance raffles fall under the terms of an 'incidental lottery'. As such, the group does not require a license.)
